Did You Know?

- Under Card Check, workers would lose the protection of a secret ballot election in union organizing drives.
- Because the decision to sign up for a union would be made publicly, union organizers would know which workers had refused to sign a card.
- Employers and dissenting workers would be powerless to resist union pressure tactics.
- Card Check could also take away workers' ability to vote on the terms of a new union contract — including their own pay and benefits.
- Union organizers could approach workers virtually anywhere — even at their homes — to get them to sign a certification card. A union could be certified before employers, and many workers, even knew an organizing drive was underway.
